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The Animal Care Assistant certificate program is designed for students who want to work in the animal care field or to gain skills to help them transfer into and succeed in Alfred State College's Veterinary Technician AAS program. The Animal Care Assistant certificate gives these students hands-on skills that will help them find employment in animal care, or to develop the skills and knowledge to help them be successful in a Veterinary Technician or another animal care related academic program if they wish to continue their education after completing the certificate.

CONTINUING EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES

Students who complete the Animal Care Assistant (ACA) Certificate3 Program and achieve the following benchmarks will be admitted to the Veterinary Technology program to pursue the AAS degree and be eligible to sit for the Veterinary Technician National Exam (VTNE) and earn licensure.
